Tax breaks would be extended to developers who upgrade old but worthy industrial and commercial buildings, many of them mills, under a bill passed by the General Assembly. An example would be the **Monohasset** Mill on Kinsley Avenue in the Valley neighborhood, where Erik Bright, above, fields a cell phone call on site. The mill is being rehabilitated by four artists with substantial subsidies from the City of Providence. The citywide tax-break initiative would need Governor Almond's approval.
